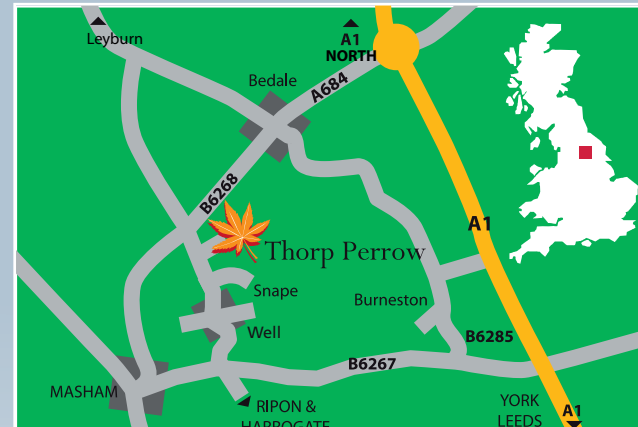

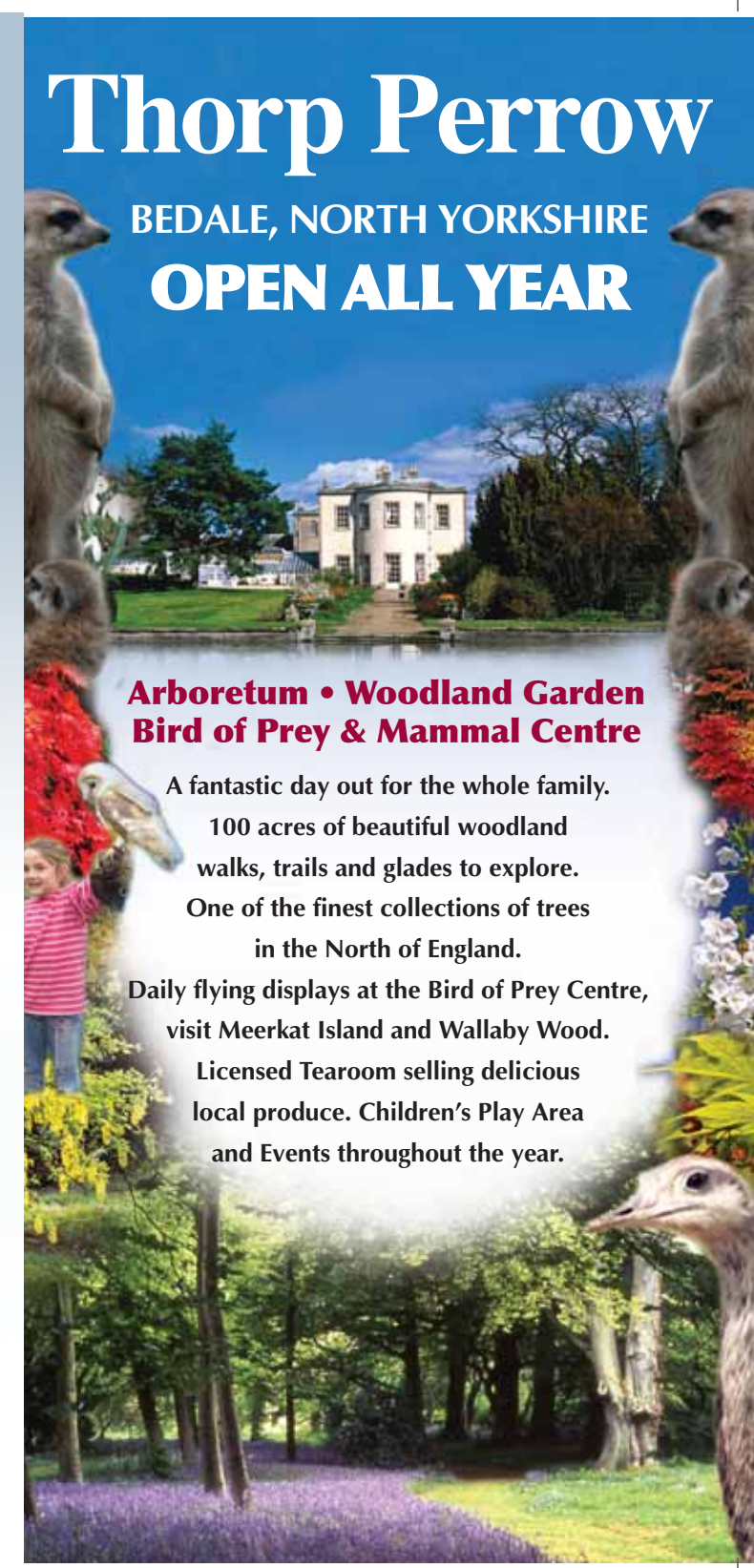

Thorp Perrow

Thorp Perrow Arboretum is situated near the historic town of Bedale, and is one of the finest collections of trees and shrubs in the country. The Arboretum is unique to Britain, if not Europe, as it is the creation of one man, Colonel Sir Leonard Ropner Bt (1895-1977). It is now owned and managed by his son Sir John Ropner Bt.

SPRING

Snowdrops and crocuses herald the coming of Spring. The woodland then bursts into colour with thousands of daffodils, anemones, violets and primroses and a myriad of other bulbs. Blossom laden trees follow and then carpets of bluebells and flowering shrubs.

SUMMER

Wildflowers, bees, butterflies, dragonflies and newly fledged chicks. Celebrate Summer with a picnic at one of our outdoor theatre productions or join one of our many events with plenty of activities for kids.

AUTUMN

A blaze of fiery reds, oranges and golds. The colours are a spectacular display so enjoy a Guided Tour or discover the countless types of fungus to be found on one of our Fungus Forays.

The Falcons of Thorp Perrow

At the bird of prey conservation and captive breeding centre there is the opportunity to learn more about birds of prey and associated wildlife. In spring time our baby owls and falcons hatched through our breeding programme, create great excitement. There is plenty of hands-on experience for all members of the family – especially children.

Entertainment

Our regular flying demonstrations will not only enable you to witness the breathtaking ability of our eagles, falcons, hawks, vultures and owls, but also give you the chance to participate in the fun. Our entertaining demonstrations, held three times daily weather permitting, are second to none with lively and informative commentary.

Mammal Centre

You now have the opportunity to visit our new Mammal Centre, including Meerkat Island and Walk Through Wallaby Wood!! An informative Guided Tour and Talk will take place daily at 12.15pm.

Education & Courses

A Hawk Walk gives you the chance to fly a hawk, within the splendour of the Arboretum, under the guidance of our experienced staff. For the aspiring falconer, the centre now incorporates The Northern School of Falconry & Associated Studies, a range of courses are available throughout the year.
